Since day one the practice has embraced continual improvement. "Over the years, Arlington Chiropractic practice has evolved significantly to better serve our patients. We've embraced new treatment options, techniques, and technologies" Josh explains. Today the menu spans chiropractic care, acupuncture, massage therapy, decompression, ultrasound and

muscle stimulation, along with DOT exams, drug and alcohol testing, and wellness products.

Whole-family wellness sets ACA apart. "We treat patients of all ages, from infants to seniors," he emphasizes. "Whether it's helping newborns with gentle adjustments, supporting growing children with posture and spinal health, or providing pain relief and mobility solutions for parents and grandparents, we focus on whole-family wellness." From the first greeting, "we strive to create a warm and family-friendly atmosphere where patients feel comfortable and understood."

Business ownership brings its share of hurdles, yet Josh sees them as fuel for growth. "Every day is a challenge as a business owner but we take things one step at a time. We look at every challenge as an opportunity to better serve." The payoff, he says, comes when "helping someone find relief from chronic pain, regain mobility, or improve their overall well-being."

Their service extends beyond clinic walls. "We believe in giving back to the community by being available and supportive of the town in any way we can," Josh notes—whether that's sponsoring youth sports teams, donating locally, or lending professional advice. Asked for one piece of wisdom for new entrepreneurs, Josh is succinct: "Surround yourself with good people who have good intentions and are there to support you to navigate new business ownership."
